Cat Adoption Team's Cat Food Bank began with the simple mission to keep pets with the families who love them and out of local animal shelters.

Who benefits

Cat owners struggling in the weakened economy don't have to choose between paying their utility bill and buying cat food for their pet. They come from as far as Vancouver, WA and Yamhill County as well as right around the corner in Washington County.

Companion cats stay with their family and receive nutritious cat food to keep them healthy.

Local animal shelters, already fraught with helping more surrendered animals than in years past, are happy to see these cats are kept with their families.

Home-bound cat-owning seniors also receive cat food for their pets through a partnership with Washington County Meals On Wheels.

Over 2,900 pounds distributed each month to feed almost 300 cats a month.

History of the Cat Food Bank

Opened in June 2008, CAT's Cat Food Bank is the first organized pet food bank in the Portland area. That first Sunday, 16 families were aided and 45 cats were fed for the month. Over 3,700 pounds was given away in the first six months.

Now, the Cat Food Bank hands out **over a ton of food each month** to feed hundreds of pet cats. Demand is high in Oregon's tough economy as evidenced by the over 624% increase in client need in just over 2 years.

In November 2010, we handed out a record breaking 4,182 pounds of food.

The Cat Food Bank is **100% donation driven** – bags of donated cat food are collected and brought to CAT's shelter or cash donations are made so CAT can purchase food at a reduced cost.

It's not **just** cat food. We provide cat behavior information and resources for subsidized spay/neuter services, as all cats fed through the Cat Food Bank must be fixed.

Here's how you can help:

Host a cat food drive at your workplace, church, or club: we'll provide you with signs, posters, and collection box/barrel.

Drop off donations at CAT's Sherwood shelter or one of the drop off locations listed on CAT's web site. (catadoptionteam.org/catfoodbank)

Needed: Dry cat/kitten food, canned/wet food, cat treats, scoopable litter.
